COMPETITORS APPLYING FOR A NZ VISITOR FIREARMS LICENCE

Competitors travelling to New Zealand to participate in the NRANZ National Championships are advised to submit an application for their NZ Visitor Firearms Licence and firearms import permit – ideally some months, but in any case at least one month – prior to their intended travel date.

The online application link is: <u>https://forms.police.govt.nz/firearms/visitors-application</u> and once completed, your application is sent direct from the Police website.

How to apply:

- 1. Go to the link and submit an online application for your visitor licence. Include the make, model, calibre and serial number/s of your firearms, where requested on the form. Where details of the NZ licence holder are requested, insert the name Ross Mason, and Licence number S0231978.
- 2. Ensuring your passport and firearms licence expiry dates do not expire whilst you are in NZ, take colour scans of your current passport identification page and your home country firearms licence.
- You will receive an emailed confirmation of your application receipt shortly after applying. The email will request copies of your passport and firearms licence if current copies are not already held on the NZ Police database. Attach your passport and firearms licence scans and return the email to the confirming arms officer's email address.
- 4. Once your application is assessed, you will receive an email confirming your licence has been granted, declined or if further information is required.
- 5. Once granted, further information relating to your arrival in NZ will be advised.
- 6. The NZ Visitor Firearms Licence fee is payable on arrival at your NZ airport of entry.
